These values, rooted in the vision of the Guardians of Life, transcend divisions and invite us to reimagine our role on Earth and in the universe.

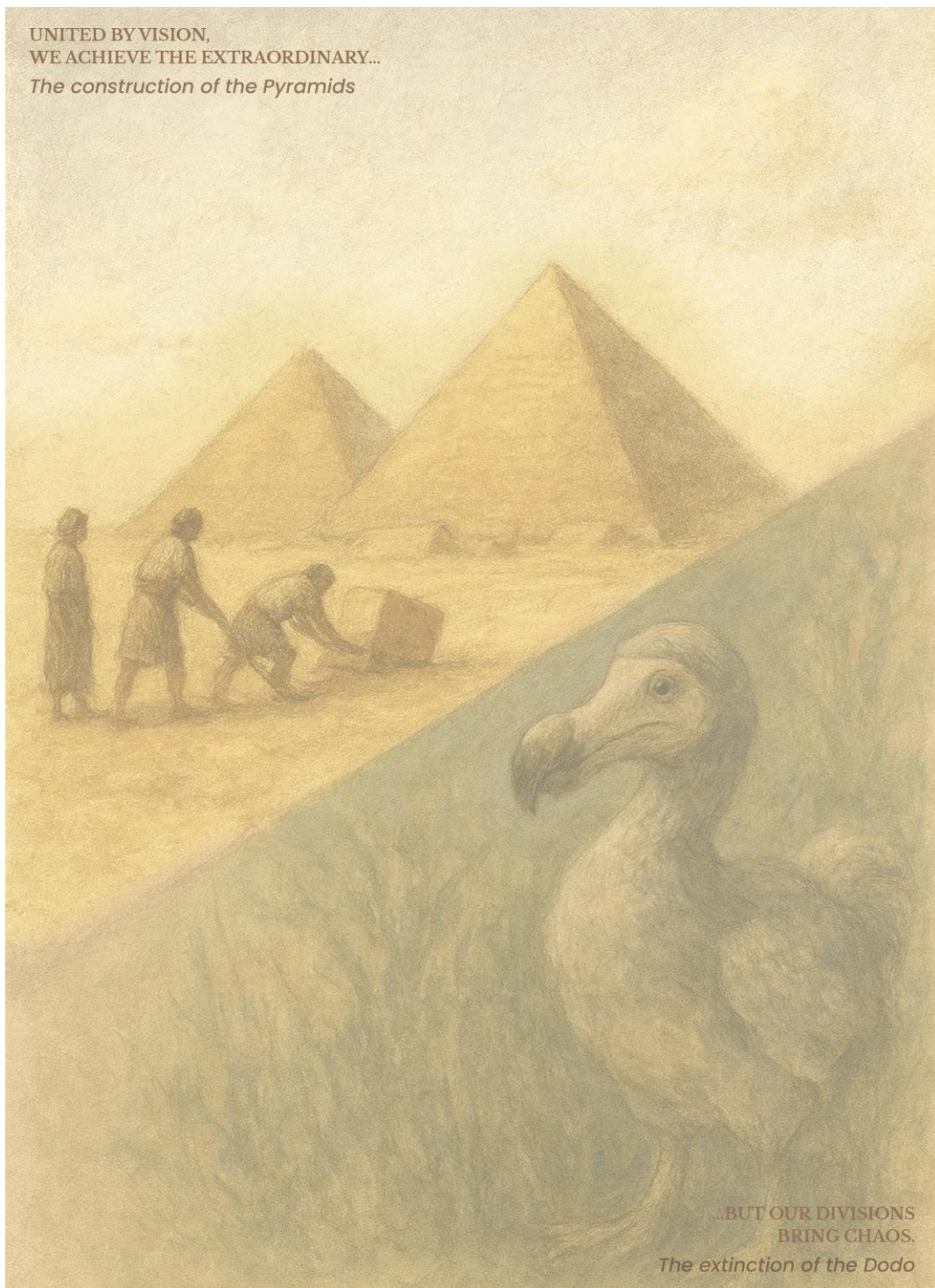

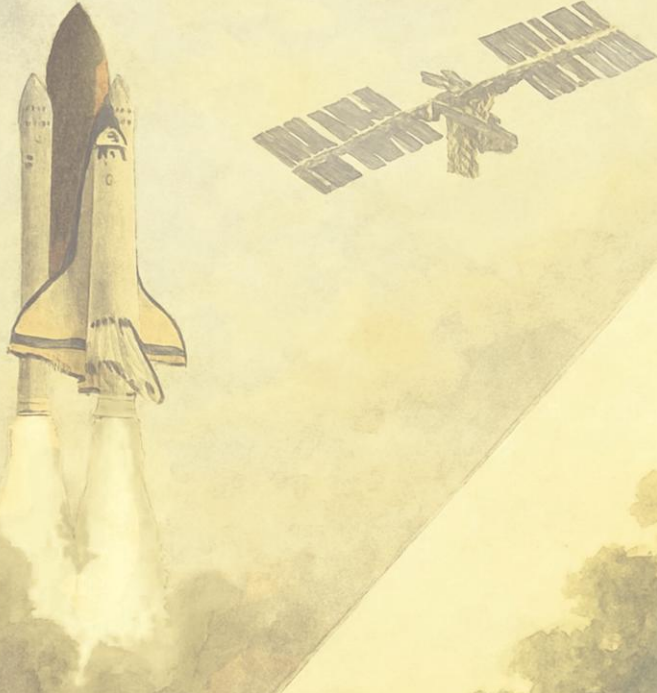
The Tower of Babel: A Telling Division

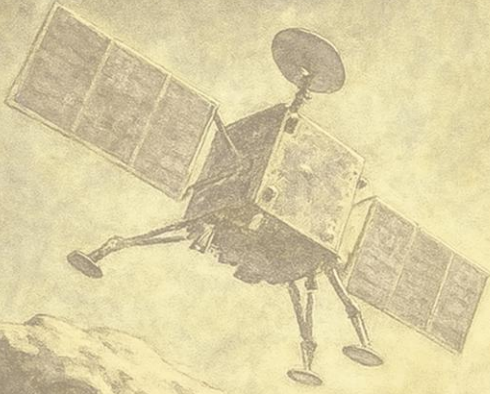
